- o Review of Current Financials
  - Mike Bakarich reviewed the district's October 31 financial statements. Current net position of \$2,509,193.
  - Accounts payable, September \$161,597. Accounts payable October \$134,837.
  - Ratify September/October expenditures as approved by Scott & Hugh motion approved.
  - Late/turn off/turn on fees. DW charges \$35 to turn off and \$35 to turn back on. Bow Mar late fee is 5% or \$15, was decided to keep an eye on it and discuss at January's meeting.
  - Motion was approved to make the switch to Chase. We may not need a lockbox in the future, they will supply a check scanner to deposit hard copy checks. It was decided to keep the lockbox for now.
  - Budget funds at year end projected to be \$687,482. No big expenses this year so may

come in closer to \$700k.

 Motion was approved to adopt Resolution 2024-11-01 as well as the 2025 budget at 11.317 mills.
