\circ Financial

- o Review Current Financials
 - Mike Bakarich reviewed the district's June 30th financial statements. Current net position of \$2,605,500.29. Mike is a little concerned about the increase in monthly water purchases, last month was \$112,623.
 - Audit, initial findings based on historical net position of \$2,558,631, clean opinion no issues.
 - July / August expenses/payables approved.
 - Key Bank deposited \$11k into the wrong account and this wasn't the first time it has been done. It was recommended to switch to Chase, fees are equivalent or better.
 - Cynthia on 2025 budget forecast on fees. In staying with our policy to charge 2% over DW water & sewer rates she's suggesting a total of 5.5% on water and 6.75% on sewer.

• Maintenance and Operations

- July/August 12 locates, water maintenance completed by end of September for the year.
- 2025 O&M budget proposal. Suggesting \$156,658 of which \$70k for emergency response, including \$20k for sewer repairs and \$50k in water main fire hydrant contingency.
- Capital plan for 2026 includes an increase for significant root intrusion.

o New Business

- Motion was approved to execute Tim Flynn's engagement letter.
 Tim Flynn has a long history, is very knowledgeable in our business and fees will not change this year.
